

How to use this worksheet

1

Look at the reference cell

Each row shows the correct dot pattern for that letter on the left.

2

Fill in the blank cells

Draw, colour, or stick a small dot in the matching circles in the blank cells alongside it.

3

Say it out loud

Say the letter name and dot numbers as you fill each one in.

4

Try it without looking

Cover the reference cell and try filling it in from memory.

Tip for parents & teachers

Print a few extra copies — repetition across several short sessions works better than trying to complete the whole sheet in one sitting.
